

Javelins in the Hoop



What you will need:

- an area to spread out hoops and throw the javelins
- a soft foam javelin for each child
- A selection of words written on individual cards

What you do:

- Give each child a javelin
- Set out hoops at different distances with a selection of words in them.
- The children throw the javelin and must choose a word from the hoop closest to where their javelin lands.
- The children must read the word to an adult and if correct brings it back to the starting point. If incorrect it stays in the hoop.
- Once there are no more words remaining in the hoops the game is over. The child (or team) with the most cards is the winner.

Learning Benefits:

- Practice with reading and recognising high frequency and/or words you are currently teaching
